## Getting Started....

- ❖ Bring driver's license, social security card, and birth certificate.
- ❖ Fill out student information and instructor will give orientation on the process of program.
- ❖ Student will take entrance surveys to determine placement and instruction level.
- ❖ Once level is determined, lessons will be prescribed for instruction.

## Computer and instruction

Use website called *Learning Express Library*



- ❖ Lessons are self-paced using computer.
- ❖ Guidance through lessons is given by instructor (in books and computer lessons).
- ❖ Instructor on-site at all times.

## The final Step.....

- ❖ Practice test is given once lessons are completed to determine readiness for GED test.
- ❖ Sign up for test online at practice center.
- ❖ If student has gone through classes at center, they may be eligible for scholarship to pay for official test.
